

Deep Diver Specialty

As a PADI Advanced Open Water Diver your maximum depth limit is 30 meters. There are, however, many exciting things to see beyond this depth. Mystical wrecks, magnificent seascapes and many pelagic fish species can all be found in the deep. On the PADI Deep Diver Specialty course you will learn about the techniques and equipment needed to safely dive to the maximum recreational depth limit of 40 meters.

Dare to go deeper! To enroll in a Deep Diver course you must be over 15 years of age, be certified as a PADI Adventure Diver (or equivalent) and fill in and sign a medical statement.



The course is structured in two parts.

You receive a manual and video which you study at your leisure completing four open water dives. This is done over two days at Portland in Dorset (weather permitting), Vobster dive site in Somerset or the National Diving Centre near Chepstow in Wales. This is as deep as you can go in recreational scuba training and is run by only our senior instructors giving you a feel for depth and pure excitement!

The cost for the course is £179 which includes manual, video, tuition, equipment*, one air fill and certification.

If you complete the course on one of our holidays the cost is £119. Not included are transport to the dive site, accommodation and entry or boat fees which are payable locally.

* For all courses subsequent to entry level you must provide your own basic equipment of mask, fins, snorkel, wet suit boots and gloves if required. For the Deep Diver Specialty you must also provide an underwater timing device.
