

DSAT Tec Trimix Diver

For the extreme diver ready to further explore the world of technical deep diving, the gas of choice is trimix. The DSAT Tec Trimix Diver course takes you to the outer edges of technical deep diving, opening the door to pristine dive sites few divers ever see.

The DSAT Tec Trimix course is intended to extend the depth range available to technical divers by utilizing helium in the gas mix. It builds on previously learned technical diving skills and concentrates on the hazards, risks and techniques of using helium mixes at depth. The course will train you to 75 meters and also gives the foundation to extend your depth range well beyond this limit.

The course consists of theory sessions and open water dives. It is performance based but usually runs over 7 or 8 days. The academic work is conducted as independent learning and at our dive centre in Chiswick and the open water dives are conducted at a variety of UK sites, Malta, Red Sea or Cyprus.

To enroll on the Tec Trimix course you must be 18 years of age or older, a PADI Rescue Diver or equivalent and a DSAT Tec Deep Diver or equivalent.

The course costs £599

Included are materials, instruction and certification.

Not included are equipment hire, dive site entry, boat fees or gas (including instructors).

Note: Helium is expensive so gas fees can be substantial.
