

PADI Twin Set Diver Specialty

Diving with two cylinders gives the diver more gas, greater redundancy in case of equipment failure and better balance underwater.

The purpose of the Twin Set Diver specialty course is to familiarize divers with the skills, knowledge, planning, configuration, procedures, techniques, problems, hazards and benefits of diving with twin scuba cylinders. The Twin Set Diver specialty course is intended to serve as a safe, supervised introduction to recreational diving with dual scuba cylinders. It is also a great introduction to technical diving.

To enroll in the Twin Set Diver course you must be 15 years or older and be a PADI Advanced Open Water diver or equivalent

The course consists of an evening of theory and pool work followed by one day of open water work consisting of two open water dives. These can be done either locally or at a coastal venue.

The PADI Twin Set Diver Specialty Course costs £150 which includes instruction, certification and equipment hire* and one air fill

Not included are transport to the dive site, entry or boat fees and subsequent cylinder fills which are payable locally.

Twin Set Try Dive

It is also possible to do a try dive using a twin set in our purpose built dive pool. The session takes a couple of hours and costs £35

***Note: For courses subsequent to entry level you must provide your own basic equipment of mask, fins and snorkel, gloves and wet suit boots. Dry suits may be hired at a reduced rate if students have the relevant dry suit experience.**
