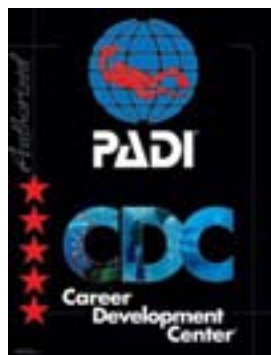
Instructor Development Program 2012

The objective of the Instructor Development program is to prepare you to become a PADI instructor. The program involves a varied curriculum of presentations, confined and open water workshops, discussions and candidate teaching presentations. The program consists of the Assistant Instructor course (AI), the Open Water Scuba Instructor course (OWSI) and the Instructor Examination (IE). When the AI and OWSI are done in combination they constitute the Instructor Development Course (IDC).

LSD was awarded Career Development Centre (CDC) status in 2009, 2010 and again in 2011 highlighting our success rate above normal IDC centres. This is an award given by PADI denoting exceptional performance in instructor training and is rarely given. Our Course Director was awarded Platinum Status, an award achieved by only 60 Course Directors worldwide. You will not find a more professional team ready to begin your training and when it comes to your professional training you should demand the best.

Not all IDC's are the same and all you have to do is ask anyone who has taken an IDC at London School of Diving. Our record is exceptional with a 100% pass rate and all you have to do is ask anyone who has taken an IDC at LSD as to our professionalism. Our aim is beyond making you pass the IE. It is to make you great Instructors.

The AI course focuses on educational methodology and starts to develop candidates teaching abilities in the classroom, pool and open water as well as concentrating on the courses that Assistant Instructors can independently conduct. Upon completion of the AI course the candidate can enrol on an OWSI course. The OWSI course further develops candidates teaching abilities, introduces the entire PADI educational system, elaborates on business principles within the dive industry and prepares candidates for the Instructor Examination and "real world" teaching. Upon completion of the OWSI course the candidate can attend an IE.



The IE is a two day evaluation of candidate's skills and knowledge conducted by PADI staff. Upon successful completion of the IE the candidate becomes a PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor.

At London School of Diving we like to give quality instruction and above average service. As part of this commitment to excellence we provide an IDC preparation package where we evaluate and critique confined water skills as well as Divemaster theory review sessions on physics, decompression theory & the Recreational Dive Planner, physiology, equipment and skills and the environment.

During the IDC we also conduct a number of classroom, pool and open water workshops that are not included in the standard curriculum. We believe this will help candidates become far more prepared for real life teaching as well as the Instructor Examination.

Prerequisites

- PADI Divemaster or Assistant Instructor or leadership level certification with another organisation (*Check with the dive centre for equivalency*)
- Age 18 years or older
- Proof of 60 logged dives
- Be a certified diver for at least 6 months
- Emergency First Response Primary & Secondary Instructor and Care for Children Instructor
- Have a medical signed by a doctor stating that you are fit to dive. This must be within the last 12 months. If you are attending an IE your medical dates must also cover the IE or you must submit a new one at the IE. If you are planning to teach in the UK then you will need an HSE diving medical
- It is assumed that candidates attending the IDC are competent in the knowledge and skills learnt on the PADI Divemaster course

London School of Diving Course Structures

As we have 24 hour access to classrooms and pool we run the IDC in a variety of formats to suit our candidates differing lifestyles and preferences.

Full Time UK

This is an intensive seven day program with the academic and pool work conducted at our CDC London dive centre and the open water work conducted at either our local lake or at the lake to be used for the IE. It is run in conjunction with a UK IE which either directly follows the IDC or is done shortly after IDC completion. LSD has a proud 100% pass rate and offer IE guidance with our Course Director.

Full Time UK with Red Sea Completion

This is an intensive seven day program with the academic and pool work conducted at our London dive centre over seven days. We then fly out to Dahab where we complete the open water components of the IDC followed by the IE. We then complete the week with 2 or 3 days of boat or shore diving where candidates can choose just to dive or take advantage of the reduced rates available for the Speciality Instructor courses.

Part Time UK Completion

To suit candidates who do not wish to enrol on a full time IDC we run a number of part time IDC's during evenings and weekends. The academic and pool work is conducted at our London dive centre and the open water work is conducted at our local lake. At the orientation session for the course we draw up a schedule to suit all of our candidate's requirements and target a UK IE for completion.

eLearning IDC Completion NEW 2010

After enrolling, PADI's eLearning system presents you with interactive presentations that include videos, audio, graphics and reading. Short quizzes let you gauge your progress, and review and correct anything you might happen to miss. This lets you move through the program efficiently and at your own pace. The PADI Instructor Development Course online is \$320 (US). The fee covers nine separate topics online to prepare you for the practical sessions needed to complete your Assistant Instructor course or Open Water Scuba Instructor course. The two programs combined are the full IDC.

Full Time Red Sea IDC

Twice yearly LSD will host an IDC in beautiful town of Dahab in the South Sinai. This will be run through a CDC centre in Dahab where full training is given in the year round warm waters. This is an intensive eight to nine day program. The IDC in Dahab is followed by the 2 day Instructor Examination and you will have guidance during this with our staff. After the IE we spend 2-3 days conducting specialties in sites such as the famous Canyon, Blue Hole and Gabr el Bint national park. LSD will arrange everything from flights to accommodation to make your trip there an experience to remember.

The Instructor Process at London School of Diving

Module 1 - EFR Instructor

The Emergency First Response Instructor Course provides the training necessary to teach the Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR), Secondary Care (First Aid) and Care for Children Courses. The course builds on the candidate's skills as primary and secondary care providers and focuses on developing their instructional abilities. Through independent study, classroom sessions and practice teaching assignments, instructor candidates learn to conduct the Emergency First Response program. This is a requirement for the IDC and lasts 1 day. All materials are included.

Module 2 - IDC Prep

This 1 day course is not compulsory to take but we highly recommend it prior to the IDC. We refresh areas of theory and review essential Rescue skills. As continuing education skills are now an integral part of the IE we teach knot tying and lift bag skills as well. There are also mock IDC exams in the theory subjects. If it's been some time since your DM course then this will be extremely valuable to you.



Module 3 - IDC

This is an intensive 7 day training where you will learn how to teach diving. The course is run by our Platinum Status Course Director and all our support staff are Master Instructors. We cover all aspects of teaching from the PADI Open Water course right up to PADI Divemaster effectively using teaching aids and instructional support material. We develop your ability in classroom, confined water and open water teaching presentations arming you with all the skills necessary to pass the IE and become a quality instructor.

There are about 40 hours of presentations throughout the program and we teach beyond the required minimum sessions. We feel that adding in extra confined and open water sessions is vital to your success and understanding of the PADI Philosophy. We leave nothing to chance as your successes are our successes. Upon completion of the IDC we are confident that you will have received the best training possible to attend the IE. Typical course hours are 08:30 to 17:30.

Module 4 - Instructor Examination (IE)

This is a 2 day evaluation process run by PADI staff where you will be asked to teach one confined water session, one open water session and one knowledge development presentation exactly like you have learned on the IDC. You will also be required to sit a five part theory exam on Physics, Physiology, Decompression Theory and the RDP, Equipment & Dive Skills and Environment. You will also be required to sit an open book standards exam. All the passing scores for these are 75%. Candidates will also be required to complete a demonstration quality rescue scenario. Upon successful completion of all these parts you will achieve the PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor rating.



Module 5 - Master Scuba Diver Trainer Prep Course

Straight after successful completion of your IE we can get you moving up the ladder by teaching you how to teach 5 Specialties with our Course Director. This really is a lot of fun and will give you a definite edge against other newly qualified instructors. We typically run Dry Suit Instructor, EANx Instructor, Deep Instructor, Wreck Instructor & Navigation Instructor but can teach others depending on interest.



Deciding on where to do your IDC is extremely important as the process can be a costly one and you need to make sure that you get the best value for your money and that those teaching you have right experience. At LSD we are confident that you will get the best training possible and invite you to come and chat to our Course Director and have a look at our facilities.
